

Basic Overview:

On Crazy Hat Night, the children are encouraged to wear a crazy hat. Ball caps, cowboy hats, sombreros, winter hats, dress hats, or other objects (towels, boxes, buckets, bowls, etc.) that look like a hat will count. Encourage the children to attach anything they like to their hat (i.e. balloons, paper, strings, etc.). Always make sure that they check with parents before spruce up their hat. Extra points can be given for any crazy hats and a prize for the craziest hat of all.




