

Basic Overview:


On Strange Shoe night, the children are encouraged to create their own shoes or wear shoes they would not normally wear to Expeditions. Explain to the kids that three points will be given to anyone who designs their own shoes (out of things likes boxes, bottles, paper plates, plastic cups, cardboard, etc.). Two points will be given to anyone who wears unusual shoes (like flippers, bedtime slippers, high heels, flip flops, water shoes, dress shoes, etc. One point will be given to anyone who is wearing two different shoes (so if they want to trade one of their shoes with a friend this would mean both have two different shoes on). You can also give out a special award for the strangest shoes.

Additional Ideas:

Be careful to avoid relays and races during game time on this particular night as it will be very difficult to run with these kinds of shoes on.


