FUN NGH Mismatch Madness Night

Basic Overview:

On Mismatch Madness Night, the children (and leaders) are encouraged to wear clothes that do not match. Everyone will earn extra points for wearing <u>styles</u> that do not go together (like a formal button up shirt and sweat pants or shorts over your pants), <u>patterns</u> that do not go together (like polka dots, stripes, and flower prints), <u>colors</u> that do not go together, or for wearing two types and colors of socks or two different types and colors of shoes.
