FUNDE Winter Dress Guess Night

Basic Overview:

Winter Dress Guess Night is a fun night in which a number of fun nights are combined into one. Kids will be instructed to choose from a list of three possible fun nights and must come dressed and ready for <u>only</u> one of those. In opening time, you will put the names of all three fun nights into a hat and draw them out one at a time. Then you can see who made the best icy dress guess for your night. The fun nights we recommend using for this night are: Mitten Mania Night, Splendid Scarf Night, and Crazy Hat Night. These specific nights were chosen because there is no overlap where the kids could dress up for two in attempt to get credit for another night. Emphasize that the kids must choose <u>only one</u> of these nights to dress up for or they do not get any credit.

Though these are included on the flyer, here is what is considered "dressed up" for these fun nights: MITTEN MANIA NIGHT - Wear gloves of any kind on both hands. Both hands must have a glove on them in order to count. The best gloves for icy weather are winter gloves, but any gloves will count! SPLENDID SCARF NIGHT - wear a regular scarf or create one out of items such as wool, balloons, foam noodles, strings, tin foil, cardboard, socks, etc. The best scarf for icy weather is a wool scarf, but any scarf will count! CRAZY HAT NIGHT - wear a hat of any kind on your head. The best hat for icy weather is a winter hat, but any hat will count!

They are a couple of ways that you can award points. (1.) You can draw just one fun night out of the hat and give a point or prize to every child who chose that Icy way to dress for the night. (2.) You could also give two points to each person who dressed in the way that you pulled out of the hat and one point to everyone who dressed up at all for the night. (3.) You could draw all three nights out one at a time and give out the most points for the first one you draw and less points for each subsequent one drawn out after that (for instance, give three points for those who wore a scarf (because that was drawn out first), two points for those who wore a hat (because that was drawn second), and one point for those who wore gloves (because that was drawn third).
