





Hi. My name is George Muller. I'm from the town of Kroppenstedt, Prussia. Prussia would later change its name to Germany. I was born there in 1805. My father was a tax collector for our town. He wanted my younger brothers and me to learn how to handle money, so he gave us money, and then he wanted us to tell him how we had spent it. Many times, when my dad asked where I had spent the money, I lied to him. I lied about what I had spent the money on, and how much money I had spent. I was spending money doing a lot of things that I shouldn't have been doing. When I ran out of money, I went home and stole some of the money that my dad had collected as taxes. One time, my father set a trap and caught me stealing. He punished me and decided to send me away to the Cathedral Classical School to try to fix my behavior. Very soon though, I figured out new ways to trick my father, and I continued to spend money.


Galatians 5:22-23 -

You are supposed to have some “fruits” growing in your life as well. Those fruits are not apples and bananas; but love, joy, peace, and faith. 
