

Basic Overview:

This fun night is designed to get the kids to say a bunch of checkpoints from their books. How it works is that you will give each classroom a brown paper bag with skittles© inside of it. As you know, skittles© come in a variety of colors. Yellow skittles will act as your golden nuggets. The person who finds a yellow skittle© will get a special prize.

Set this night up by separating all of the yellow skittles© from the rest of the skittles©. Put enough non-yellow skittles© in the bag for each person to have 7-8 skittles©. For instance if you have a class of 15 children times seven skittles each equals 105 skittles©. Then place 2-3 yellow skittles© in the bag.

Each checkpoint that the child completes will earn them a chance to reach in and grab one skittle© out of the bag without looking. Those who do not get a yellow skittle© can eat it. Those who find a golden nugget (a yellow skittle©) can show it to the leader or commander for a special prize. At the end of book time, the leaders can give out any remaining skittles© to the kids by letting them pick one, two, or three out at a time. Again those who get a yellow skittle© get a special prize.


