


## Psalm 4:8 -






#### Dear Explorer,

One year, a new law was passed that said that the factory had to set up a school for us. The classes were late at night. Most kids were too tired from working all day to go to school, but I loved learning so much that I forced myself to go and stay awake. Most people in my time thought that a person could not be a Christian and also study science. One Sunday, a missionary came to our church. He said China really needed missionaries who were also doctors. Perhaps I could be a Christian and study science after all. I asked the Lord to save me, and I decided that I would become a medical missionary.






**1 Corinthians 14:33 –** For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.






