FUNNGHT IDEAS That's the Ticket Night

Basic Overview:

This fun night is designed to get the kids to say a bunch of checkpoints from their books. How it works is that you bring a roll of raffle tickets (can be purchased at a Walmart © type of store in the "office" section). Give the leaders in each classroom enough tickets for each person to have 7-8 tickets. For instance if you have a class of 15 children times seven tickets each equals 105 tickets. Since the tickets should go in number order make sure that you write down the starting number and the ending number of each batch of tickets that you give out and what classroom you gave them too.

Each checkpoint that the child completes will earn them one ticket. At the end of book time, the leaders can give out any remaining tickets to the kids. For instance if they have 25 tickets left over and 15 children in the class. Give each child one more ticket and then you'll have eight leftover tickets that can just be thrown away.

At the end of the night you bring everyone into the same room and read off the winning tickets. Try to ensure that each classroom has a winning ticket from it (and an alternate winning ticket in case the one you call is one of the leftovers that got thrown away). Those who hold the winning ticket can come up to the front and choose a prize.
