FUN NIGHT IDEAS Silent Night

Basic Overview:

Silent Night is a Christmas Fun Night with a play off of the Christmas Carol "Silent Night." At the beginning of the night, each child is given a triangular piece of paper. The point is for them to not talk at all or make a sound with their mouth throughout the night (including game time). If they are caught talking, their leader will tear one corner off of their "triangle." If they continue to talk, they continue to lose corners. At the end of the night the children will turn in their triangle and will get pieces of candy based on the number of corners that they still have left on their triangles. If they still have all three corners on their triangle, then they get to pick three pieces of candy. Two corners will mean two pieces of candy and so on.


Additional Ideas:


