

FUN NIGHT IDEAS

On the Spot Night

Basic Overview:

This fun night is designed to get the kids to complete a bunch of checkpoints and verses from their books. How it works is that one of your leaders (preferably your commander) will cover themselves in spots before Expeditions. Use different colored washable markers and draw spots that are the size of a pea or marble. Put the spots on your arms hands, neck, face, and even a couple on your stomach. Tell the kids you have spot all over yourself even in places like your stomach that you aren't going to show them.

Each checkpoint that the child completes will earn them a chance to take one guess as to how many spots they think you have on yourself. Give them a range at the beginning of the night of say 50-150 spots (you can make a smaller range for the 1st graders to guess between).

At the end of the night (or possibly the following week in opening time), give any child who guessed correctly a prize. If no one guesses right number of spots, give a prize to the one who is the closest. You could also give smaller prizes to the second and third closest guessers.

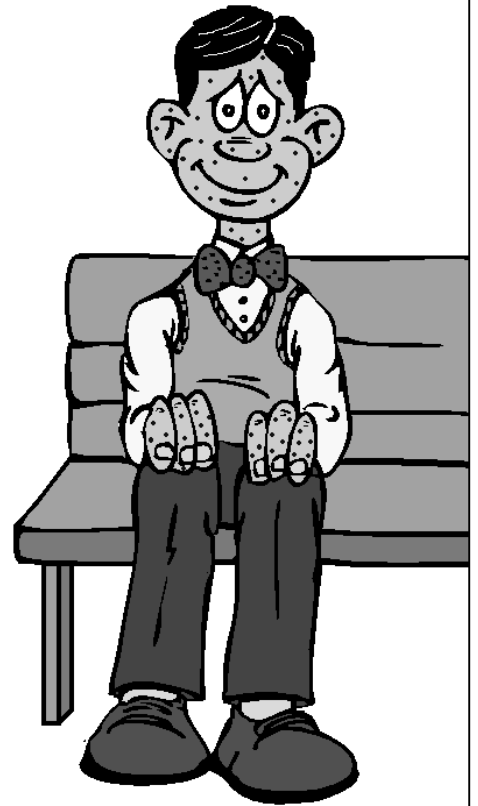
