

Basic Overview:

This fun night should be done at the end of the year and really is the kids last chance to complete checkpoints out of their books for the year. There are three things you can use to motivate the children to finish the year strong:

First of all, you can offer a special prize to the child who completes the most checkpoints on this night. Have leaders keep a tab and award whichever child completed the most at the end of the night.

Secondly, after doing this your first year, you can establish some "world records" for the kids to try to break in future years on this night (for instance..."last year someone set the record of finishing 16 checkpoints in one night...can anyone beat that record this year?" or "last year 6th graders combined finished 45 checkpoints...I wonder if any class can beat that record this year?")

Thirdly, you should remind the children that they might only be a few pages away from earning a medal or other great award at the awards ceremony, which will be following this night in a week or two.

You can also allow the kids to stay back from game time to complete more checkpoints on this special night if you want to.
