

Basic Overview:

On Silly Sock Night the children are encouraged to wear any color socks except plain white. As with every fun night, conscious effort is required. Most children will wear white socks to church normally, so by not allowing white socks, you are awarding or recognizing those who planned ahead and wore something to participate.

Remind the children to wear any color or mix of colors (i.e. red, blue, pink, orange, black, etc.) socks for this special night. They can also wear socks that are striped or polka-dotted. Extra points or a special prize can be given for any especially silly socks (like those with individual toes in them or multiple pairs of different socks).

Additional Ideas:

Think of ways in game time to incorporate socks. Perhaps having the children take off their shoes and play some of the games in their socks or just having those who have silly socks play a particular game.
