## - N N- Punch Out Night

## Basic Overview:

This fun night is designed to get the kids to complete a number of checkpoints from their books. The way this night works is that each child will be given a punch card at the beginning of book time. On their punch card, they will write their name and grade. Each classroom will also be given a single hole puncher (available at Dollar Stores, Walmart, Target, etc.). Each time a child gets a page signed off in their book, the child will then take their punch card to their leader and choose one circle to have their leader punch out with the hole puncher (this can be any of the circles that are numbered 1-40 on their card).

At the end of book time, the leaders in the classroom will pull out a secret envelope that has a punch card inside with all the correct answers on it (this can just be a punch card that you have already pre-punched ten numbers out of). For instance, those who punched out the numbers $3,8,14,15,19,23,24,29,34$, and 37 would get to pick a prize. Allow the child to pick a prize (a piece of candy) for every punch that they got right.

If you cannot locate a hole puncher, you could also use a black marker to color in the circle for the child. We recommend that you only have one marker per classroom so that the kids don't freely color in other circles without completing pages out of their books.
